

M. J. MAXSON MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP

Red Deer County administers the Magnus Johann Maxson Memorial Scholarship Fund, which was established to assist deserving grade twelve graduates from the County schools with the expenses of their first year at a publicly funded post-secondary institution in Alberta.

One scholarship of \$500 is available annually to a grade twelve graduate from the following schools in accordance with the outlined criteria.

Approved County Schools:

Bowden (1), Delburne (1), Innisfail (1), Penhold (1), Spruce View (1), H.J. Cody, Sylvan Lake (1), and Chinook's Edge Career Schools (1)

CRITERIA

- 1. The recipient must reside in Red Deer County.
- 2. The recipient must have earned an Alberta High School Diploma.
- 3. The recipient must not be eligible to receive the Alexander Rutherford Scholarship awarded by the Alberta Government at the grade twelve level. The recipient in any school will be the eligible student with the highest average based on the composite final marks reported by Alberta Education in any four of:
 - ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS 30 LEVEL, SOCIAL STUDIES 30 LEVEL, MATHEMATICS 20 LEVEL, SCIENCE 20 LEVEL. See complete table on page 3.
- 4. The recipient must produce evidence to show that he/she is attending a publicly-funded post-secondary institution in Alberta in the first year of a program leading to a Ministry-approved degree or certification.
- 5. In cases of ties, the scholarship will be divided equally between the winners.

PROCEDURES

- 1. When all criteria have been met, the principal or school office shall submit the recipient's name to Red Deer County, Community Services.
- 2. A cheque shall be issued in the recipient's name. Red Deer County will contact the school office to coordinate arrangements for formal awarding of the scholarship.
