**PROGRAM INFORMATION:**  
The purpose of the program is to provide delivery of frozen meals to residents of Red Deer County, the Town of Bentley, the Town of Ponoka, the Village of Innisfail and the Village of Dinosaur who are well looking during the Covid-19 pandemic.

**HOW DOES THE PROGRAM WORK?**  
Interested individuals fill out and submit application forms about their delivery. Application will be reviewed at an alternate address, phone number, and any special considerations about the delivery. Staff will then call the individual to verify their information for the delivery will be working.

**HOW CAN I GET THE PROGRAM?**  
The program can be made via Facebook (a group) or by dropping in to meet with staff (no charge to be given). Delivery phone change form to be submitted to the County office. Cards for individual meal orders are \$1.00 and family meals are \$2.00 (please see form for more details).

**WHEN IS MAKING THE MEALS?**  
Meals are being continuously prepared by local groups and both meal programs follow the Canada Food Guide. Orders will be taken once a week.
