Who wants to play a game of Dodge -ball?



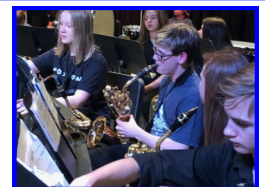
The senior high wing had six teams who all joined into a week long tournament. Everyday during the Flex periods High School students headed down to the gym to participate in this team building sport.
