

Achievement Award

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Eligibility Pertaining to Applicants

General

- Children¹ of co-operative members of gas utilities within the Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops, as well as, children or landowners who are serviced by gas member towns, villages, counties, or bands.
- Memberships must have been in place at least one full year.
- Children of active members of the Provincial Federation Board are NOT eligible.

Awards

• Four (4) Five hundred dollar (\$500.00) awards will be granted annually.

Acceptable Institutions and Courses

- Admission to first year of a degree or diploma or apprenticeship program at any Canadian accredited post secondary institute of learning with the following restrictions:
 - > Students attending an institution in the Province of Alberta will only be eligible.

Academic Standards

- Candidates must have completed the course work of the last one (1) year of schooling required for admission to the post secondary institution and must have obtained an academic standing of at least seventy five percent (75%) in core subjects.
- Applicants not achieving at least this standing will NOT be eligible.

¹ The definition of child(ren) is: Natural child, legally adopted child, step or ward in legal guardianship

Entrance

- Upon graduation from high school/CEGEP, candidates must be prepared to enter the
 educational institution on a full-time basis and be enrolled in a course of study leading to a
 degree, diploma or certificate.
- This will also apply to apprenticeship programs of different lengths
- Candidates are responsible for ensuring that the results from their final and next-to-final year
 courses prior to admission at selected institutions are sent to AMSC together with their
 application by October 1, following graduation.

Selection of Winners

- Winners will be selected by a committee appointed by AMSC
- Preference will be given to those applicants entering a field which applies to the Natural Gas Industry (e.g. Power Engineering, Millwrights, Gas Utility Operators, Machinists, Heavy Equipment Technician, and Steamfitter/Pipefitter etc.)
- Awards will be announced at the Federation of Alberta Gas Co-ops Ltd. Annual General Meeting (each Fall)
- Winners are only entitled to receive an award once in a lifetime

Evaluation

- The evaluation of applicants will be based upon their written essay (minimum 250 words)
 discussing themselves, their goals and why they believe the Federation should grant them an
 award.
- Applicants must provide, two (2) reference letters from any combination of teachers, employers, coaches, or ministers, <u>provided they are not relatives</u>. These references should emphasize the qualities they feel the applicant displays which makes them an appropriate candidate for this award.
- Applicants must also provide academic transcripts, and any achievement in extracurricular and community activities.
- Applicants must have their forms signed by their local Federation Member Utility.

Obligation of Winners

- Winners must maintain a full load of study on a full-time basis to attain a degree or diploma or certificate, as the case may be.
- Winners must submit to AMSC proof of admission from the educational institution as soon as selected.
