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2018 Scholarship Application



The following are the criteria for awarding the scholarship:

AMOUNT OF SCHOLARSHIP:

13 Scholarships of \$1,000, plus

1 Bonus Scholarship of \$1,500 for a total of \$14,500

APPLICATION DEADLINE:

April 30, 2018

ELIGIBILITY:

As follows

Credit Union Membership

Candidates or an immediate family member must have continuously been a member in good standing at Mountain View Credit Union prior to January 1st, 2018 and be recommended by that branch.

Education

A candidate must be entering post-secondary studies for the first time, having graduated from high school within the last two years.

Transcript of Marks

All candidates must provide an academic transcript of their high school credit courses taken to date. Prior to receiving the scholarship, successful candidates must provide the credit union with an "Official Transcript" showing all courses completed; http://www.education.alberta.ca/students/transcripts.aspx

Eligible Institutions or Courses of Study

Candidates must enroll in a recognized accredited post-secondary institution in Canada.

Selection Criteria

The scholarship will be awarded based on a number of factors, which include academic achievement, financial budget/planning, community or volunteer involvement, and leadership displayed. Candidates may only receive this award once.

Letters of Reference

Candidates must provide two letters of reference, e.g., teacher, guidance counselor, employer, community leader.

Essay

Candidates must submit an essay of 500–800 words describing their achievements, community or volunteer involvement, educational goals, and future plans.

Selection Decision

A committee chosen by Mountain View Credit Union will make the selection of successful candidates. Their decision is final and not open to debate. Applications and accompanying documentation will not be returned to the applicants.

Photograph Publication

Recipients of the awards must agree to provide a copy of their graduate photo and have their name and photograph published. Applicants under 18 years of age must have the consent of a parent/guardian (see consent at bottom of application).

Confirmation of Enrollment

Candidates who have been successfully chosen to receive the scholarship must provide confirmation of enrollment in the post-secondary institution, prior to receiving the funds. Enrollment may be deferred for a maximum period of one year upon written notice to their branch by September 1, 2017. Failure to enroll in the program or institution identified on the application may result in forfeiture of the award, in which case the committee may make the award available to another candidate.
